

CUPE Local 786 Membership Process

In accordance with the CUPE National Constitution, all new employees in the bargaining unit who wish to become a member of the Union are required to sign a Union card (Article B.8.1), pay an initiation fee (Article B.4.1), and be sworn in by your Local President or designate (Article B.8.4). As outlined in the Local 786 by-laws under section 10 (d), the initiation or readmission fee is \$2.00. This can be paid via Interac E-transfer to office@cupe786.org. Once these steps are completed, you are eligible to participate in the business of the Union as a member in good standing (Article B.8.3).
